Overview

The 38th Space Symposium was held at Broadmoor Hotel in Colorado Springs, U.S., over four days from April 17 (Mon) to 20 (Thu), 2023. Back in 2021, because of the COVID-19 pandemic, on-site participation was limited, and the event was held in August. Then, in 2022, although the pandemic situation had largely normalized, a multitude of restrictions were in place due to the implementation of COVID-19 infection control measures and border control measures. However, this time, with other 12,000 attendees, being the largest ever, the venue was completely full, and there were sessions where seating was not available. There were times when I was told that I could watch the show on my mobile phone outside the venue and that I didn't even need to come in! Also, this event saw a multitude of Japanese government officials attending, such as those from the Ministry of Defense and the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, along with people from JAXA and the private sector.
